KIDS' CLASSICS"

GOFISH

This deck contains 41 cards consisting of 1 rule card and 10 sets of 4 matching fish cards.

OBJECT OF THE GAME

Players try to get as many pairs of 2 matching fish as possible before someone runs out of cards and ends the game. The player with the most pairs at the end of the game wins!

RULES

Go Fish can be played by 2 or more players. Deal each player five cards face down and place the remaining cards face down in a stack to form the draw pile. Each player may now remove any pairs held in his hand, and put them face up in front of him on the table. The player to the left of the

dealer may now ask one of the other players for a card that matches one in his own hand. If the player who was asked has the matching card in his hand, he must give it to the player who asked for it. When the player receives a "no" answer, he must "go fish" from the draw pile. If he happens to draw the card he was asking for, he may place the matching cards from his hand in front of him on the table, and take another turn. When the player does not draw the card he was asking for, it becomes the next player's turn. When one player runs out of cards, the game ends. The player who has the most pairs is the winner.
